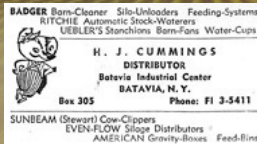

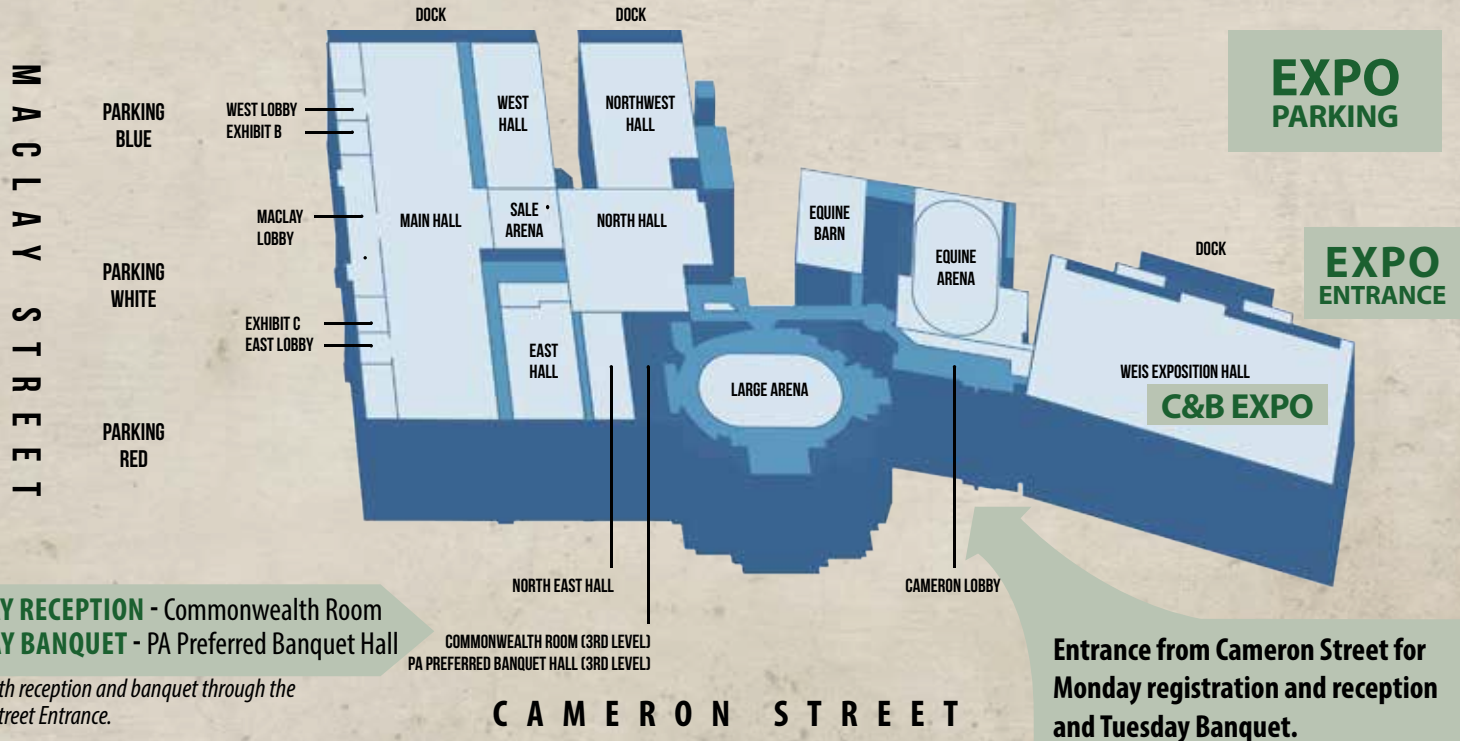

FARM SHOW COMPLEX MAP



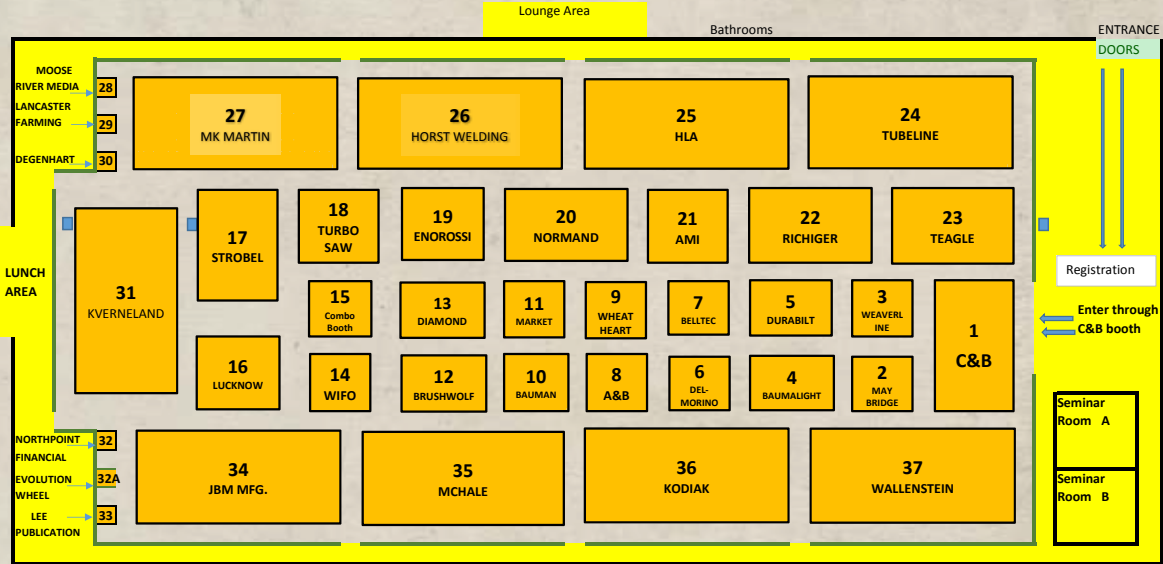
